Indonesian men who are married before the age of 19 can expect a lower quality of life. Ahmad and Fajar are friends. Ahmad marries early and Fajar waits a bit longer. Otherwise, up to that point they have had a very similar life.





PUTRI

Indonesian women who are married before the age of 19 can expect a lower quality

of life for themselves and for their children, compared with women who wait a few

years. Putri and Dewi are friends. Putri marries early and Dewi waits a bit longer.

Putri is less likely to work and, if she does, she is about 35% less likely to work in the formal sector.

DEWI

Dewi.

is much more likely to have a marriage certificate than

PUTRI

Putri earns about 25% less than Dewi for every hour she works.

PUTRI

is 60% more likely to get divorced than Dewi

DEWI

is about **3.5 years older** when she has her **first** child. She is more likely to have a doctor or nurse present when the baby is

born, and more likely to get a birth certificate.

Dewi is more likely to report that she is satisfied with her life.

PUTRI

has more children, but those children are worse off.

They are about 20% more likely to die in their first 12 months of life and about 15% more likely to be stunted.
